*** DTH SCHOOL CORONAVIRUS UPDATE ***

Dear DTH Families,

We hope everyone is faring well during this difficult time. As you may have seen in our most recent e-blast, the COVID-19 crisis has significantly impacted our operations, **resulting in a \$1.3 million loss in immediate revenue**. We are utilizing a number of resources and putting in place plans to help us weather this storm, but we also recognize that this may have a lasting impact on DTH and non-profits arts organizations across the country.

That being said, we know that we will see our way through this and be stronger on the other side, because we are Dance Theatre of Harlem. We are reaching out to share a few updates.

1. In alignment with NYC Board of Education, we are planning to reopen the DTH School on Monday, April 20, 2020, when NYC Schools reopen. However, we recognize that this timing is fluid and can change at any moment. In light of this, we will be rolling out a series of online classes, exclusive to our DTH families, as well as a series of classes that will be available to the general public. Official announcements will be going out in the coming weeks.

2. Due to the directive from the Governor's office we have had to cancel our NYC Season next month. Our hope is to reschedule our performances to another date in 2020, but at this time that has not yet been determined.
